

Hence S 65 W. 10.75 chs. to a Spanish Oak 3x thence N 63 W. 7 chs. to a Black Gum 3x thence S 79 W 16 chs. to a small Red Oak 3x thence S 40 E. W. 14.50 chs. to a Stake 3x. on said River thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning corner. A more full description may be had on a reference to a plat hereto annexed. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Alfred Nightower his heirs & assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alfred Nightower his heirs heirs and assigns against myself and my Heirs and against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. The first nor to be conveyed has such bounds Marks &c as follows containing three Hundred & Twenty five Acres more or less 1/2 Beginning at a Black Gum 3x on the west bank of said River, thence N. b. W. q chs. to a Hickory 3x thence S. 53 W. 52 chs. to a Red Oak 3x thence S. q E. 17.50 chs. to w. Black Oak 3x thence S. 4. W. 19.50 chs. to a Stake 3x thence due North 27.50 chs. to a Stake 3x thence N 88 W. 56.50 to a White Oak 3x thence N 15 W. 20 chs. to a Spanish Oak 3x N 70 E 27 chs. to a Stake
