P. Brockman his heirs, Ex. Admrs. or assigns forever. & I do hereby warrant and defend the title from every person or persons lawfully claiming the same, and from myself my heirs, Ex. Barton's line thence up the meanders of said Creek a ditch to an Iron Wood Corner on the East bank of J^d Ditch thence westwardly to a Wild Honey Tree near the grave yard thence up the old highway
