Know all men by these presents that I John Charles Jr of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars to me paid, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James Pickett of the same State and District his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and eighty seven acres more or less, it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to Wilson Cobb the 3rd day of January 1825 and Conveyed by said Cobb to the said John Charles Jr. Situate in said District on the waters of Broad Creek of Saluda River and hath such bounds Marks & as follows viz: Beginning at a Spanish Oak 3x on the Trail Road thence along said Road S10 W. 10 chs. To a stone 3x by a pine Stump thence N89 W. 1350 chs to a stake 3x thence N45 W. 4150 chs to a Persimmon bush 3x near a branch. Thence S. 80 W. 2750 to a Stake at a fork of a branch by a long rock in said fork near David Garrison's. Whence up said branch by the former meander of the same to a Maple 3x on said branch thence S69 E. 74.50 chs. to a small Pine 3x on the aforesaid Trail Road, thence along said road S14 W. 9.25 chs to a bend in said road, thence S28 W. 12.30 chs to a bend thence S. 8 W. 16.32 chs to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the lights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said James Pickett his heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executives and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Pickett his heirs and assigns against myself myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
