I know all men by these presents that I Zachariah Smith of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and Fifty five dollars to me in hand paid by Ephraim Liles of the District and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ephraim Liles all that tract or parcel of land on which I have lived for many years containing one hundred and seventy five Acres be the same more or less situated in the District and State aforesaid on Branches of Brushy Creek waters of Enoree River Beginning on a Red Oak 3x on Joseph Woodall's original line and running with said line S 65° E. 2.50 to a Post Oak 3x thence S 80° E. 7.50 to a Red Oak 3x thence S 12° E. 11 Chains to a Red Oak 3x thence N 80° E. 25. to a Hickory 3x thence S 50° E. 15.75 to Hickory 3x thence N 12° W. 12.25 to a Stake 3x thence N 8° W. 28 Chains to a Red Oak 3x on Farrar's line thence with said line N. 60° W. 44 to a Stake 3x thence S 19° W. 39 to the beginning corner which bounds contains the land to be conveyed together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the above described premises unto the said Ephraim Liles his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend the above described premises unto the said Ephraim Liles his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and Administrators and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and Seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of November One thousand and Eight hundred and thirty nine and in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Independence of America.
