The State of South Carolina Personally came John S. Mayfield of Greenville District before me an Acting Justice of the aforesaid District and made oath in due form of Law and said that he was present and saw William Pollard Senr assign and deliver the within Goods of conveyance to John Ashmore Junior for the use and purposes within mentioned and that he also saw the subscribing witness with himself - witness the same. State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents Anderson District that I Thos Blasingame of the State and District aforesaid for the love good will and affection which I have and bear unto my daughter Eliza Archer wife of Washington Archer of Rutherford County in the State of Tennessee have given granted made over and confirmed - and by these presents do freely give grant make over confirm and deliver unto the said Eliza Archer to her only use benefit and behoof and to the natural heirs of her body in the following manner & not otherwise, To Wit Two negroes Manah and Mary (Manah about the age of Fifty Years & Mary about eleven Years. and the future increase of the said negroes - to remain continue and be in the power and possession of the said Eliza Archer during her natural life
