 that I Joseph Powell of the Village of Greenville in the District
 and State aforesaid have this day for and in consideration of
 the love and affection which I bear for & to my son John Dickson
 Powell emancipated him from the service which he was bound
 by Law to perform until the age of twenty One Year. he being
 born on the sixth day of September in the Year One thousand
 eight hundred and twenty five, and will reach his twenty
 first Year on the sixth day of September One thousand eight
 hundred and ³³² forty six, all persons therefore trading or
 dealing with the said John Dickson Powell will look to him
 for his contracts, and any property which he may by
