To John Hightower. Know all men by these presents that I Samuel Corbin of the State of South Carolina Greenville District of the One part, and John Hightower of the State & District aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth, that for the considerations of the sum of One Hundred Dollars in Hand paid to the said Samuel Corbin the receipt is hereby acknowledged. Both bargained sold & delivered & do by these presents bargain sell and deliver unto John Hightower a certain tract or parcel of Land containing One Hundred and fifty six acres, being in the State and District aforesaid lying on the branches of Fall Creek Waters of the North fork of Saluda River. Beginning on a Chestnut Oak thence N. 80 E. 54 chains to a Hemlock thence N. 10 E. 30 chain to a Stake, thence S 80 W. 54 chain to a Stake, thence to the beginning corner.

To Have & to hold all Woods Water & Water courses profits privileges Hereditaments & appurtenances belonging to the aforesaid premises, I the said Samuel Corbin do warrant & ever defend the right & title of the aforesaid tract of Land to John Hightower & his heirs forever, from all persons lawfully claiming of the same. In Witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixth day of March in the Year of Our Lords One Thousand eight Hundred and twelve and in the thirty fifth Year of the Independence of the United States of America, signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us
