

Writs of *Habeas Corpus* issued out of the Court of Common Pleas
held for the District of Greenville One tested the fifth day
of December in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight
hundred and Forty Eight at the Suit of R. Lovelands to me
directed commanding me that of the Goods and Chattle Lands
and Tenements of James Brown to bere the sum of One Hundred
and Fifty Dollars damages and costs I have seized and taken
of the lands and Tenements of the said James Brown all that
Certain piece parcel and tract of land containing more or less
One Hundred acres situate and being in the district of Greenville
and State aforesaid adjoining Lands of P. Hamet et al. (The above
Lands having been leased on by W. Henning former Sheriff & sold by
him sale day in July Eighteen hundred and forty and Titled not having
been made by him) I hereby make Titled agreeable to to the act
in that case made and provided it appearing to My Satisfaction
that the purchase Money has been paid.

And Whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since
the seizure by me made by virtue of the said Writs of *Habeas Corpus*
before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue and
purchased by Roger Lovelands of the District and State aforesaid
for the sum of Fifty Dollars being the highest sum that was
bidden therefor. Now Know Ye that I W. M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid
by virtue of the said Writs of *Habeas Corpus* aforesaid, to me
directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the Statute
in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration
of the said sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid or secured
to be paid by the said Roger Lovelands the receipt and payment whereof
I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these
presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Roger Lovelands his heirs
and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its
appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and interest, which the said
James Brown of Right had of in and to the same. To Have and to hold
the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto
the said Roger Lovelands his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and
absolutely as I the said W. M. Goodlett Sheriff might could or ought
to grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the Statute
aforesaid, and the said Writs of *Habeas Corpus* or otherwise.
