John W. Southern & Deed of Sale for 111 Acres of Land <sup>24</sup>

To Joseph Brown Esq State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I John W. Southern of Granville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and thirty three dollars to me paid by Joseph Brown of the same State and District, have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Brown a certain tract of land situate in said District on Waters of Mountain Creek of Enoree River containing One hundred and seven acres it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Isaac Green and hath such bounds marked &c as follows (viz) Beginning at a Pine stump 34 near the Rutherford Road thence S. 75. E. 14 chs to a Stake 34 on a branch thence down said branch N 88 E. 6. 50 chs to a Maple 34 thence N 12 W 39. 25 chs to a chestnut 34 near the Spring branch thence N 85 W 35 chs to a Red Oak 34 thence S 12 W. 19 chs to a fallen down Pine 34 thence S 38 E. 16. 75 chs to a Hickory 34 thence N 80 E. 15 chs to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Brown his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph Brown his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
