E. 10. ch to a red oak on the north bank of Greens creek and to the beginning, containing by estimation Three hundred acres more or less, together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, I do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Mrs J Green forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs J. Green his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
