Reubin Masten } The State of South Carolina } This Indenture made this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Reubin Masten of Greenville District in the State aforesaid of the one part and Andrew B. Crook of the same State and District of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Andrew B. Crook stands justly indebted to the said Reubin Masten in the sum of Nineteen hundred dollars (\$1900.) it being the true amount of a note given by the said Andrew B. Crook to the said Reubin Masten the day and year above mentioned and due the fifth day of August A. D. 1841 by the principle sum, the interest to be paid annually a reference to which note will more fully appear. Now this indenture Witnesseth that the said Andrew B. Crook for and in consideration of the said debt or sum of pay able as aforesaid to the said Reubin Masten according to the tenor and effect of the note aforesaid and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Andrew B. Crook by him the said Reubin Masten in hand paid. at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant bargain sell and release and confirm unto the said Reubin Masten his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract of Land situate in said District on the North fork of Saluda River containing six hundred and eleven acres more or less it being the same tract of Land sold and conveyed to the said Andrew B. Crook by William Thurston Senr. the fifth day of August A. D. 1842 a more full description may be had on reference to said deed it also being the same tract of Land originally owned by the late Col. Henry M Wood decd. Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to
