Marshall William A Pamplin and Mary Pamplin of the County of Lincoln State of Tennessee do hereby nominate and appoint Spartan Goodlett of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina our Attorney in fact to demand and receive for us from the Administrator or Executor of Dennis Marshall or any person or persons having possession of all or any portion of our distributive share of the Estate of said Dennis Marshall now deceased late of the said Greenville District in the State of South Carolina and all necessary receipts bonds and acquittances for us and in our names to execute for and about the same We do further empower our said Attorney to sue for and recover the same or any part thereof whether the same be real or personal Estate & for that purpose to make and employ one or more Attorneys under him and to all other acts and things to accomplish the objects of this power at our expense and charge & we hereby ratify all the lawful actings & doings of our said Attorney in the premises as fully as if we were present and doing the same ourselves.
