Cooley of State and District aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and three dollars & fifty five cents to me in hand paid by Lucinda Cooley of State aforesaid and District of Greenville have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said Lucinda Cooley all that tract or parcel of Land containing Two hundred acres (more or less) situate in Greenville District adjoining Land belonging to Elizabeth Vincent, Hiram Cooley and Elizabeth Pinnell also Saluda a boundary on the south it being the tract whereon my mother Nancy Cooley now resides. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Lucinda Cooley her heirs and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless and upon condition that if the said Lewis Cooley his heirs, executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Lucinda Cooley her certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators or assigns the full and just sum of one hundred dollars and fifty five cents on note with interest from 12<sup>th</sup> of March 1842. On the 1<sup>st</sup> day of next march then and in such case, and in all times from thenceforth these presents and all the estate hereby granted and every article, clause and sentence herein contained, shall cease, determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes, anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of.
