Lavinia Pallman in open Court and being duly sworn, deposeth & saith that it is bona-fide his intention to become a citizen of the United States, and renounce from all allegiance and fidelity, to all foreign Princes, Potentates, States or Sovereigns whatsoever, and particularly all allegiance which he may in any manner owe to the King of Great Britain or to Her present Majesty Victoria, Queen of the United Kingdoms of Great Britain and Scotland of which Kingdom he was a subject and within whose Dominions he was born.
