Deed of Gift No 3 I have for my wife and children, and also for the sum  
 of one dollar, to me in hand paid have granted, bargained, sold and given  
 and by these presents do grant, grant, bargain & sell unto John McCleary  
 Nathan Nesbitt, James C. Allen, Jackson D. Gumas, Xenophon P. Perry  
 and William H. Perry, trustees, their executors & administrators, the follow-  
 ing named property. First, one negro Girl, named Sey, for the sole use &  
 benefit of my daughter Sarah A. Durham, during her natural life, &  
 after her death, for her children the issue of her body with the further  
 increase of the said Girl. Sey, Secondly, eight horses, two wagons  
 four beds furniture, seven negroes, (viz) Bob, Martha, Allen, Sam,  
 Edney, Perry & Elena, together with the future increase or issue of the  
 said Martha, Edney & Elena, To Have and to hold the said property  
 during mine & my wifes lives, with the understanding & this express-  
 condition, that myself, wife and the children that remains with  
 me are to be comfortably supported & for the sole trust & benefit of  
 my said wife & children, my trustees have the power & are hereby reques-  
 ted to sell any of the above property and to lay out the proceeds in land  
 and some other stock that will be needed for the use benefit of the family.  
 At my death my trustees will divide the property equally among my  
 children, Melinda, Xenophon, Mary C. Francis, William H. Hudson P.  
 Teresa L. Augustus, Susan, Nancy & Louiza, so as to make them equal  
 with my other children, Matilda, Elizabeth, & Sarah A. to whom I have  
 given one negro Girl each, the remainder (if any) to be equally divided am-  
 ong the whole, so as to make all my children equal at last, Given  
 under my hand & Seal this 28<sup>th</sup> of December 1842. The word Melinda interlined  
 before signing is in presence of John Ford Jr.
