 Isaac Davenport } State and District aforesaid } for and in consideration of the natural
 love and affection I have for my son Isaac Davenport, and in
 consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said Isaac Davenport
 of the said State and District aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, released and
 given and by these presents do give, grant, bargain & sell unto the said Isaac Davenport
 a plantation & tract of land lying in the State & District aforesaid, in the waters of Horse
 Creek of Roedy River being the tract of land that the said Isaac Davenport now lives
 on. Beginning in a P. C. 3x thence S. E. C. 46. 25. to R. C. 3x (down) thence S. 44 W. 24. 25.
 to a post R. 3x, thence S. 37. W. 15. 10. to a post R. 3x, thence S. 56 W. 13. 90. to S. 5. 3x, then
 S. 39 1/2 W. 39. 30 to R. C. 3x, thence S. 70 E. 42. to a pine 3x, thence S. 57. E. 20. 50. to the
 beginning. Containing one hundred ninety five and a half acres be the same, more
 or less, but retaining to myself and wife the privilege of using any of the timber on
 the place as long as either of us live, and at our death to be given up to the said Isaac
 Davenport. Together, with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments &
 appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To Have & To hold, all and singular the said premises, above mentioned unto the
 said Isaac Davenport, his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself
 my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant forever defend all and singular
 the said premises to the said Isaac Davenport, his heirs and assigns, against myself
 and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof, Witness my hand & Seal this 22nd day of July A. D. 1838
 and in the 62nd year of the Independence of the U. S. of America Signed, Sealed,

 9th November 1842.

 Chandler, of the State and District aforesaid, have given, granted, bargained,
 sold and released, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell & release
 unto the said Temperance Chandler, after my own and my wife's death, the plan-
 tation where I now live, and tract of land as described below, lying in the
 State and District aforesaid in the waters of Horse and Mountain Creeks.
 Beginning in a P. C. 3x, thence running S. E. C. 53. to a Stake 3x, bounded
 by lands belonging to I. and John Kirby, thence S. 88 1/2 E. 37. to a Stake 3x, then
