I, To Greenville District, I. Erwin P. Jones of Cope County in the State of  
T. P. Butler, Georgia, and late of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for &  
in consideration of the sum of one thousand, seven hundred & fifty  
dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas P. Butler of Greenville District in the State  
aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant,  
bargain sell & release unto the said Thomas P. Butler, All that piece or parcel  
of land situate near the Village of Greenville on the Burnembe road nearly oppo-  
site the residence of Major E. D. Castle, Beginning at a Stake near the said  
Burnembe road, and runs north 37° W. 6 chs 32 links to a Stake near the said road  
thence S. 53° W. eight chs to a small P. Oak, then a S. 37° E. six chs 32 links to  
a small black Barn, thence N. 53° E. eight chs to the beginning, containing five  
acres and eight poles by estimation be the same more or less it being the same piece  
or parcel of land conveyed to me by Vardry M'Bar Esquire by Deed dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day  
of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty nine (1839)  
Together with all & singular the rights, Members, hereditaments & appurtenances to  
the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, I have and do hold,  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas P. Butler his heirs &  
assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & Administrators to  
warrant & forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas P.  
Butler his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and  
seal this second day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
forty three & in the 67<sup>th</sup> year of the independence of the United States of America
