 Winsor Middleton of Greenville District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of One hundred & thirty three dollars to me paid by Winsor Middleton of Anderson County in the State of North Carolina have granted bargained, sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain, sell & release unto the said Winsor Middleton, a part of a certain tract of Land containing one hundred acres more or less, lying in the North side of the Meadow fork of Musk Creek and bounded as follows - Beginning on a Spanish oak corner on the Creek thence a straight line to a Post oak corner on the Ridge path thence south along said path to a white oak corner thence a straight line to a post oak, thence a straight line to the mouth of a branch where it enters into the creek, thence up the creek to the Spanish oak corner. Together with all & singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. I have and do hold, all and singular the premises unto the said Winsor Middleton, his heirs and assigns forever, I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant & ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Winsor Middleton his heirs & assigns and against myself & my heirs & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim any part thereof, Witness my hand & seal this the 8th day of Nov^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty one, Assigned, Sealed and delivered in the presence of, Justices
