

Edward Gantz his heirs executors adm^rs and assigns do covenant promise and agree to and with the said Richd H & Chas B Stone their heirs executors adm^rs and assigns by these presents that if default shall happen to be made of or in payment of the said sum of money as aforesaid according to the true intent and meaning of the said note so as to make the said Richard H & Chas B Stone liable for the payment of the above mentioned money that then and in such case it shall and may be lawful to and for the said Richd H & Chas B Stone their exec^rs, adm^rs, attorneys or agents from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the meannages lands or tenements of the said Edward Gantz and to take the above mentioned sum arising out of Negro men Slaves Caesar, Jack, Wesley & Sam, into the custody and possession and the same to hold and detain to the own use and behalfe as their own proper goods chattels from thenceforth and forever or the same to sell and dispose of at will and pleasure, retaining the overplus if any should happen to be, after paying the whole amount of the note and interest together with the costs if any should occur unto the said Edward Gantz his exec^rs, adm^rs, or assigns. In witness whereunto I the said Edward Gantz have hereunto set my hand and seal this the nineteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three and in the sixty seventh year of the sovereignty and independence of the United States of America.
