that I Oliver Smith of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and thirteen dollars to me in hand paid by William Smith of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Smith all that tract or parcel of Land it being a part of a tract formerly owned by David Armstrong Senr deceased and sold by the said David Armstrongs heirs to the said Oliver Smith situated in the State and District aforesaid on the mill branch waters of Reedy River containing seventy two acres be the same more or less. Beginning on a stake xiii. o.m. thence N. 74. W. 22. 50. ch. to Pine. xiii. o.m. thence S. 22. W. 37. 95. chs Pine. xiii. o.m. thence S. 83 1/4. E. 11. 13 chs to Red Oak xiii. n.w. thence N. 8. E. 4. 08. chs to Maple xiii. n.m. thence S. 84 1/2. W. 14. 50 chs to Post Oak bush in the old field xiii. n.m. thence N 21 1/4 E 26 chs to the beginning stake xiii. o.m.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, I do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Smith his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend the above mentioned premises unto the said William Smith his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs executors and administrators and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
