Cole, of Greenville District, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and Twenty-seven Dollars to me paid by Benajah Dunham and Rogu Loveland of Greenville in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said B. B. Dunham & R. Loveland, all that Lot of Land near the Village of Greenville on the Buncomb Road and runs North 38 degrees West 200 feet to a Stake thence South 21 degrees West 300 feet to a Stake, thence South 38 degrees East 200 feet to a Stake on a Street 50 feet wide, thence North 21 East 300 feet along a line of the said Street to the beginning - be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned, unto the said B. B. Dunham & R. Loveland their Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said B. B. Dunham, & R. Loveland, their Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
