 long as she may live and after her death to belong to Jane and  
 Ann Brown Daughters of said Dorothy Brown and I do hereby  
 bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and  
 forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said  
 Dorothy Brown as long as she may live and after her death  
 to belong to Jane and Ann Brown against myself my heirs  
 and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or  
 to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and
