





Known all men by these presents that I, John Spriggs of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for the consideration of twenty dollars to me in hand paid by William Cox have granted, bargained, sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell unto the said William Cox a small parcel of Land situate in the District aforesaid, on the north side of the middle fork of Saluda River beginning on a stable corner on said Coxes line thence Co. 5<sup>th</sup> East to a Hickory corner on Cleve-lands land thence a conditional line to a ditch, the line between said Cleve-lands and said William Cox thence N. 67 East to the beginning it being part of the tract the said Spriggs conveyed to said Cox containing by estimation 36 Acres be the same more or less to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Cox his heirs and assigns from me my heirs and from every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1843. Signed, Sealed and delivered in presence of us,
