Item, their Executors and administrators free of any limitation whatever, and in case of the Death of any Child or Children of the said Martha Ann Bolling living issue before the Death of the said Martha Ann, then and in such case the issue of such Child or Children shall take the part or share his or her father or mother would have been entitled to if alive. But if the said Martha Ann should die without issue living at her death, then the above property to revert back to my Estate, and my Executors is to have it equally distributed between my Legatee agreeable to my Will. Given under my hand and seal this 10<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty-four.

that I, Tully Bolling of the State and District, do hereby give and in consideration of the natural love and affection I have for my Daughter Martha Ann Bolling and one Dollar to me paid have given, granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do release, grant, bargain sell and give to my said Daughter Martha Ann Bolling during her natural life and after her Death to the issue of her body a tract of Land lying in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of Mountain and Horse Creeks, on each side of the Augusta Road, Beginning on a water oak 3x on the South bank of Horse Creek thence running S. 67<sup>o</sup> W. 50. 50. to a Red oak 3x bounded by Willis Davenport and William Anderson, thence S. 40<sup>o</sup> E. 23. 75 to a Red oak bounded by William Anderson thence S. 58<sup>o</sup> W. 55 to an oak 3x thence S. 9<sup>o</sup> E. 20 to a Red oak 3x bounded by said Tully Bolling's home tract thence N. 55<sup>o</sup> W. 36. 33 to a Red oak 3x thence S. 6<sup>o</sup> W. 10. to a Post oak 3x bounded by tractable Mr. Donaldson thence S. 50<sup>o</sup> W. 25. to a Post oak 3x bounded by land the said Tully Bolling has decided to be Daughter Harriet Westfield, thence N. 10<sup>o</sup> W. 64 to a Post oak 3x bounded by C.
