Deed for Piquet Church

This Indenture, made this twentieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five, between Charles Terry and Pamela Terry his wife

of the District of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, of the one part, and Gaston Terry, Chas Terry Wilson M. C. C. J. Terry, Equie Calhoun, William Mars, & Thomas Ford, Trustees, in trust for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned, all of the district of Greenville in the State of South Carolina of the other part - Witnesseth that the said Chas Terry & Pamela his wife in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to us, in hand paid, at and upon the sealing and delivery of these presents, that receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath, given, granted, conveyed, sold, released, confirmed and confirmed, and by these presents do give, grant, convey, sell, release, confirm & confirm unto them the said Gaston Terry, Chas Terry Wilson M. C. C. J. Terry, Equie Calhoun, William Mars, Tho. Ford and their Executors (Trustees) in trust for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned and declared, all the estate, right, title, interest, property, claim, and demand whatsoever which in law or equity shall be in the said Chas Terry and Pamela Terry his wife, both (or have) in, to, or upon all and singular a certain lot or piece of Land, situate, lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, bounded and bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at a Rock corner more thence S 24 N E to a Rock, etc. more thence S. 79 E - 8 - to Rock 3 x more thence N 24 E 4 to Rock 3 x more thence N. 66 W. 8. to the beginning corner of Cherry including four acres of Land, together with all and singular the house, woods, water, ways, privileges, and appurtenances, thereto belonging in any wise pertaining, to have and to hold, all and singular, the above mentioned and described lot or piece of Land, situate, lying and being as aforesaid, together with all and singular the house, woods, water, ways, and privileges, thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining unto them the said Trustees and their Successors in office for ever, in trust, that they shall erect and build, or cause to be erected and built thereon, a house or place of worship for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in the United States of America, according to the rules and discipline which from time to time, may be agreed upon and adopted by the Ministers and Preachers of the said Church, at their General Conferences, in the United States of America, and in further trust and confidence that they shall at all times, for ever hereafter, permit such Ministers and Preachers, belonging to the said Church, as shall from time to time, be duly authorized by the General Conference of the Ministers, and Preachers
