Know all men by these pre-
sents that I, Samuel Williams

of the State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of
the natural love and affection which I have for my grand-
daughter Jane S. Gower and also for the sum of one dollar
to me in hand paid have granted bargained sold and
given and by these presents do give grant bargain and
sell unto Miss. A. Williams and John Harper trustees their exec-
utors and administrators or certain tract or parcels of land
laying in the District and State aforesaid on both sides
of the road leading from Greenville C. H. to Augusta known
as a part of the Tonsend Tract containing two hundred and
two acres be the same more or less begining on a stone 3x thence
N. 15. 6. 6. to a stake 3x. thence N. 41. W. 42. to a Post oak 3x bounded
by Burys and Reens land thence S. 49. W. 48 to a Post oak 3x bound-
ed by Reens land thence N. 41. W. 24 to a Post oak 3x. thence S. 49.
W. 22. to a Post oak 3x bounded by Adam Jones, land thence S. 11.
W. 12. to a Stake 3x thence East 96. 50 to the beginning to have
and to hold after my death for the sole use and benefit of the
lawfull issue of her body to them their heirs and assigns with-
out limitation. But if the said Jane S. Gower should die with-
out lawfull issue living at her deathly then the said trustees are to
take the Property above named in trust for the use and benefit of
the other daughters of my son West. A. Williams to be equally dis-
tributed between them for their use and their heirs forever Given
