Know all men by these presents, That we David Hoke and B. F. Perry of Greenville District,




West of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, we have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Solomon W. West all that piece parcel and tract of land situate and being in the waters of South Sacolet River in Greenville District and State aforesaid, containing Three Hundred and thirty seven acres more or less being composed of two tracts of land, sold by Wm. Goodlett late Sheriff of said District to the said D. Hoke & B. F. Perry, viz. one tract of one hundred acres more or less sold sale day in March 1844 as the property of James Sidley at the suit of William Choice, and one tract of two hundred and thirty seven acres more or less sold sale day in March 1844 as the property of James Sidley at the suit of William Choice.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises beforementioned, unto the said Solomon W. West his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said Solomon W. West his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
