

said Thomas P. Brockman the following property (to wit) one negro man named Ned, and his wife Kelly, and their two children, Fanny and Nancy, one negro woman named Nancy, one girl named Pricy, about twelve years of age and a girl named Martha about ten years old; - The woman Kelly and her two children, and the girl Pricy to be delivered forthwith and the others against the first day of January next, To have and to hold the aforesaid Negroes and their future increase to the said Thomas P. Brockman His Heir, Executors & Administrators. Subject nevertheless and upon the following trusts, that is to say, in trust, first for the support, maintenance and Education of my said Children Francisca Louisa, and Virginia Rosalie Robe and the support and maintenance of my wife Pamela Robe during the natural life of my said wife and upon the death of my said wife then in trust for the use and benefit of my aforesaid two daughters until they arrive at the age of twenty one years, my Trustee having the power however in the event of the marriage of either or both of my said daughters before they are twenty one to let them have the use of it in negro, each, until they arrive at age, at which time should my wife then be dead, the aforesaid property is to be equally divided between my said daughters, but should my wife be still living at the arrival of age of my said daughters then one third part of the aforesaid property is to remain in the hands of the Trustee aforesaid until her death for her use and benefit, at which time such third part is to be divided between my said children - Provided however and it is hereby expressly understood that if either of my said daughters should die before the time of division of the property aforesaid leaving no child or children surviving them the share to which said daughter would be entitled for her part to and vest in the survivor; but should either die before coming of age leaving a child or children surviving them the share to which said daughter would have been entitled, shall belong to her child or children, and provided also that if both of my said daughters die before a division of the aforesaid property, leaving no child or children surviving, then all the aforesaid property and the increase is to revert to myself if living and if dead then to my legal representatives - and it is also further provided that if it should be deemed proper so to do, my Trustee shall have the power with my consent to sell or to move of the aforesaid negroes and reinvest the proceeds as may be thought advisable, the aforesaid negroes at all times to be subject to the control of my aforesaid Trustee, with the power to remove them from the state should he think it advisable to do so -
