To have and to hold the said property unto him the said James Moses and Sisleyann and Sarah Ann Smith his and their executors administrators and assigns, forever, and I the said Nancy Smith for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, the Property unto the said James Moses B. Riley Sisleyann and Sarah his and her executors administrators and assigns, against the claim of me the said Nancy Smith my executors and administrators, and of every other person whosoever shall and will warrant and forever defend.

Know all men by these presents, That I, Michael Mc Bride of Charleston in the State aforesaid, for and in considera- tion of the sum of Five Dollars and fifty dollars trade, to me paid by George Washington Hopkins of Charleston in the State aforesaid, have granted, bar- gained, sold and released, and by these Presents, Do Grant, Bargain sell, and release, unto the said George Washington Hopkins One Hundred and Fifty Four (154) Acres of Land being the North West portion of that Tract conveyed by John M. Leland, Superintendent of Public Works, to John G. Lewis on the 17 th of July 1844, and by him conveyed to me on the Third day of September 1844 Said Land being bounded on the Southeast by a National
