State of South Carolina <sup>in</sup> This Inden-  
Grenville District. I have made this  
ninth day of February in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and forty four

between John Watson ordinary of the district aforesaid and Ethel Hollyclaw  
of the said State and district. Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell  
a certain tract of land hereinafter described of the estate of Stephen Holly-  
claw deceased issued from the Court of Ordinary of said district, and up-  
on the return thereof, the judge of said Court did determine that the said  
land could not be divided without injury to the interests of the par-  
ties, and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the said dis-  
trict in three separate lots designated as lots Nos 1. 2 & 3 in a credit of  
twelve months. Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said  
land for sale on the first Monday in February of the present year. And  
whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at pub-  
lic outcry on the credit aforesaid, the lot No. 2 of the said land, when  
the said Ethel Hollyclaw was the last and highest bidder to whom the said  
lot was struck off for the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars.

Now this indenture witnesseth, That in consideration  
of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me paid, I have granted,  
bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell,  
and release to the said Ethel Hollyclaw, his heirs and assigns forever the  
aforesaid lot or tract of Land containing ninety five acres, more or less,  
situate in said district on the waters of Enoree River, near the State road,  
and hath such bounds marks &c. as follows beginning at a large Poplar  $\delta$   
on a branch thence S.  $4\frac{1}{2}$  E. 10. 44 chs. to a Rock  $\delta$  thence W.  $7\frac{3}{4}$  E. 37. 30  
chs to a Rock  $\delta$  thence N.  $15\frac{1}{2}$  W. 10 chs to a Spanish oak  $\delta$  thence C.  $4\frac{1}{2}$   
W. 27. 75 chs to a Hickory  $\delta$  thence N. 60 W. 6. 50 chs. to a Post Oak  $\delta$   
thence S. 30 W. 36. 50 chs. to a Spring thence N. 69 W. 67 chs to a Post oak  
 $\delta$  on the aforesaid branch, thence down the meanders of said branch  
to the beginning corner, a more full description may be had or refer-  
ence to a plat, bundle annexed with the aforesaid documents belonging, and  
all the estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand which the said Stephen  
Hollyclaw died at the time of his death had in or to the same.
