When the said Henry Sherman does pay off and settle and discharge the above note in full, then this obligation is to be void and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force, said negroes to be sold and to be applied to the payment of the above debt and if there should be any surplus after paying said debt and the cost that may arise thereon it is to be paid over to the said Henry Sherman Witness my hand and seal day and date above written.

defend the above described Land and premises to the said Roland
