Whereas Robert Goodlett late of said District dec'd. did by his last Will & Testament bearing date the twenty first day January one thousand eight hundred & nineteen give & bequeath his whole estate both real & personal to his brother James Goodlett during his life and after his death to go to his five sons Now be it known that we the undersigned A. D. Goodlett, Willis Goodlett, P. P. Goodlett, Wilson W. Goodlett, & David Goodlett, are the five sons mentioned therein & whereas we are desirous to give to our four sisters a negro girl apiece out of said estate our father James Goodlett consenting to the same (viz) to Nancy Russell a girl called Eliza To Elizabeth Powers, one called Polia, P. Margaret Barnett, one called Nancy, To Mary Gaston, one called Petuny, all which they now have in possession, To have & to hold the said negroes with their present & future increase to them & the heirs of their bodies forever.
