State of South Carolina I know all now Greenville District. — by these presents that I Wiley Kemp of the District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety two dollars to me paid by Darius Green of the aforesaid state and District have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Darius Green a certain plantation or tract of land situate in the District and State aforesaid lying near Brushy Creek waters of Enoree River it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Cyprian Farer and hath such marks &c. as follows commencing at a post oak corner 3 x thence S. 74° W. 26.40 chains to a stone corner near a branch thence N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 38.00 chains to a stake corner thence S. 34 W. 9.00 chains to a stake corner thence S. 51 E. 41.0 chains to a stake corner thence due S. 8.00 chains to a stake corner thence S. 30 W. 9.75 to the begining corner containing thirty seven and three fourths of an acre. together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Darius Green his Heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Darius Green his Heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1845.
