McClanahan all that Tract or parcell of Land lying in the State & District aforesaid on long branch waters of Reedy River containing Twenty acres more or less, Beginning in a chestnut corner thence N. 47 W. 10.25 to a Post oak & thence S. 44 W. 50 to a Post oak & thence a straight line back to the beginning & Together with the all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises above mentioned unto the said Samuel E. McClanahan his Heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Samuel E. McClanahan his Heirs and assigns for ever against myself my Heirs and against every Person or Persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
