To all to whom these presents shall come.
I, David Hoke, Sheriff of Greenville Dis-
trict, and State aforesaid, and Testi-
ming: Whereas, by virtue of a Writ

of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held
for the District of Greenville tested the Seventeenth day of Novem-
ber in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and for-
ty Five, at the suit of Pet. Hitchcock & Co. to me directed, Com-
manding me, that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of
J. M. A. Turpin to levy the sum of Seven Hundred & Ninety Five
Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands

that was bidder therefor: Now know ye. That I David Hoke the
Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said Writ of fieri facias aforesaid
to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the sta-
tute in such case made and provided, and for and in consideration
of the said sum of Three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid, or
secured to be paid by the said Mrs. Ann Earle the receipt and
payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained
and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the
said Ann Earle her heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece
and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right
title and interest, which the said J. M. A. Turpin of right had, of, in,
and to the same. To have and to hold the said piece, parcel
and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Mrs. Ann
Earle her heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I
the said David Hoke Sheriff might, could, or ought to grant,
bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and
the said Writ of fieri facias or otherwise.
