Gunnels in his life time, the receipt and payment whereof we hereby acknowledge, and in order the better to secure the said William Nesbitt and his Heirs the title to the said tract of land have granted, Bargained, sold, released and conveyed and by these presents do grant, Bargain, sell, release and convey unto the said William Nesbitt his Heirs and assigns all that plantation and tract of Land situate lying and being in District and State aforesaid, on the east side of Reedy River, adjoining lands belonging to the said William Nesbitt, Austin Moore, William Sims and the estate of William Choice deceased containing one hundred and forty one acres more or less, beginning at a sweet gum tree, thence East 54 chains to the Creek, thence down the meanders of the said Creek to Reedy River, thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said William Nesbitt his Heirs and assigns forever: and we hereby bind ourselves our Heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally to warrant and forever defend the right and title to the said premises unto the said William Nesbitt and his Heirs against ourselves and our Heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
