

To have, use, to hold, the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said William A. Cumble his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as I the said David Hodge Sheriff might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and the said Writs of fieri facias or otherwise.
