Washington Streets, Running S. 74 E. 200 feet to a stake, thence S.
16 W. 100 feet to a stake, thence N. 74 W. 200 feet to a stake,
thence N. 16 E. 100 feet to the beginning supposed to be one half
Acre, more or less, including the Brick House Shop and all
other Buildings on the said Lot, for a more particular reference,
see Record Book R., pages 6 & 7, for the conveyance from J. Pen-
