these presents that I Edward Stewart  
of the State and dist aforesaid for

and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me  
paid by Jacob Ponder of the same state and district have giv-  
en, granted, bargained, sold released and conveyed and by these  
presents do give grant bargain sell release and convey unto  
him the said Jacob Ponder a certain tract or parcel of land  
situate lying and being in the state and district above named  
on the South side of Beavardam Creek water of middle Tiger  
River and bounded as follows viz Beginning at a Stake on  
the bank of said creek Running South & East 5 ch to a  
black gum 3 x thence South 89° West 25 ch to a stake 3 x new  
thence North 103° West 26 ch 50 links to a stake 3 x thence North  
3 chains to a poplar on the Bank of the creek thence down  
the meanders of the creek to the beginning containing 100 acres  
be the same more or less to have and to hold the above grant-  
ed premises unto him the said Jacob Ponder his heirs and  
assigns forever together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging  
or in anywise incident or appertaining And I the said  
Edward Stewart do hereby bind myself my heirs executors  
Administrators and assigns forever to warrant and defend  
the above granted premises unto him the said Jacob
