of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars paid to me by William A. Mooney both of the State and district above mentioned have given granted bargained sold and released; and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and release unto him the said William A. Mooney a certain tract or parcel of land situate and being in the State and District aforesaid on both sides of South Packollett River, Beginning on a large black oak on the North side of said river running thence West 5 chains to a red oak thence N. 87° W. 11.25 to a Hickory thence S. 74° W. 10.54 chains to a small Pine thence N. 6° W. 11 chs to a Pine thence S. 80° W. 10.50 chs. to a small Chestnut thence S. 5° E. 11 chs. to a large Pine thence S. 15° E. 20 chs. to a small red oak thence S. 86° W. 20.75 chs. to black oak thence S. 43 W. 11 chs. to a branch thence up the meanderings of said branch to a red Oak thence East 11 chs. to a black oak thence N. 60° E. 13 chains to a white Oak thence South 15 chains to a Pine or near the 3 fork Saluda road thence with said road about N. 50° E. to a black Jack on the the North side of said road and near the same thence S. 10° E. 10 chs. to a pine thence S. 73 1/2° E. 22.50 chs. to a post oak thence N. 35° E. 8.50 to a small Black oak on the road leading from Greenville C. H. S. C. to Rutherfordton N.C. thence with said road North 23 chains to a stake thence East 2 chains to a red oak thence N. 8 W. 10 chs. to a Pine thence West 2 chains to a stake on the last mentioned road thence with said road crossing the River to the beginning, containing four hundred and twenty two acres.
