The State of South Carolina,
 Know all men by these pres-
 ents, That I, George Washington
 Hopkins, of Charleston in the State

aforsaid, Painter in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Thomas W. Malone of said City in the State a-
 forsaid, Attorney at Law, have granted, bargained, sold, and re-
 leased, and by these Presents, Do Grant, bargain, sell, and re-
 lease, unto the said Thomas W. Malone all that tract of land
 containing two hundred and fifty four acres, more or less, be-
 ing the north west portion of that tract conveyed by John
 St. Leland, Superintendent of Public Works to John P. Lewis
 on 17th July 1844, by Deed recorded in the Clerks office
 of Greenville District, Reg. Mesme Conv. Book W. pages 419
 & 420, and conveyed by the said John P. Lewis to Michel
 McPride, 3 September 1844 - Recorded in Book W, pa-
 ges 420 & 421, and conveyed by the said Michel McPride
 to me the said G. W. Hopkins in two parcels on the 10th
 & 27th December 1845 (forty five) by Deeds recorded in said
 office Book V. pages 10 & 11 - 17 & 18. The said Tract of
 land lying and being in Greenville District, on Terry's
 Beaver Dam Creek, a branch of the North Fork of the
 Saluda River and having such farm marks and bounds
 as are represented by a Plat, by John C. Hoyt Pub-
 lic Surveyor made 3 August 1837, which is attached to the
 Original conveyance from the Superintendent of Public Works
 aforsaid. The tract of land herein conveyed being bound-
 ed on the North by lands now or late of Aaron Temple-
 man on the east by a part of the said Original tract
 now belonging to George Allison towards the South-west on
 lands now or late of Wm. Kinney and Yack Phillips
 and on the North-west in part by a watercourse called
 a Creek, over which the western corner of said Tract ex-
 tends. Together with all and singular the Rights, Mem-
 bers, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Premises be-
 longing, or in any wise incident or appertaining:
 To Have and to Hold all and singular the
 Premises before mentioned, unto the said Thomas W. Malone
 his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
 my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said Premises, unto
 the said Thomas W. Malone his Heirs and Assigns, a-
 gainst me and my Heirs, and all persons whatsoever
 lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part
 thereof.
