the District and in the State aforesaid have Granted bargained sold
and released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release
unto the said George Miller All That Plantation tract or parcel of Land
situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on waters
of the Cane break Branch Branch waters of Escoee River Contain-
ing Fifteen and a half Acres be the same more or less being part
of a Tract originally granted to Uriah Conner Beginning on Red
Oak 3 x 0 m Running thence S 6 1/2 E. 24.70 chains to stone 3 x 0 m.
Thence N. 88 2/3 W. 7.88 chains to stone 3 x 0. m. thence N 88 2/3 W. 24.00
chains to stake 3 x 0. m. thence N. 88 E. 5.00 chains to the beginning
Red Oak. 3 x 0. m. Together with all and singular the rights members
incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singu-
lar the premises before mentioned, unto the said George Miller
