Bennetts line to a Stone Corner thence a West Course on L. Huffs line to a white Oak on the river thence up sd river to the beginning Corner a part of which was originally granted to Richard Lancaster Sixty acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members and all that appertains to said tract of land to the sd John Henderson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the sd premises to the sd John Henderson his heirs and assigns forever from myself my heirs and from all other persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
