Smyer the wife of S. R. Smyer has never relinquished her right of Dower in the said Lot of Land which was sold by her Husband to the said Robert McKay. And whereas she the said Mary A. Smyer may hereafter institute proceedings & recover after the death of her said Husband, her interest or right of dower in the said Lot of Land - Now know all men by these Presents, that we Robert McKay & C. B. Atwood of the District of Greenville do hereby covenant and agree with the said Richard Yeader & John Bryan giving their Heirs and assigns, for & in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to us in hand paid & in consideration of the promises above mentioned that we will indemnify & save them harmless from all claims which the said Mary A. Smyer may now or hereafter have for dower in the said Lot of Land above mentioned.
