of the sum of One thousand five hundred dollars to me in hand paid
by Charles B. Roberts of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid.
I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pre-
sents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Charles B. Roberts
all that certain Lot or Piece of Land, situate, lying and being in
the Village of Greenville in the State aforesaid. Beginning at a Stake
on Avenue Street, and running S 16 W with Jackson St. two hundred
and ninety four feet to a Stake thence N 74 W two hundred feet to a
Stake thence E 16 E two hundred and ninety four feet to a Stake on
Avenue St. thence S 74 E two hundred feet to the beginning, being the
Lot of Land I purchased of Wm E Wickliffe, by deed bearing date
the 7th day of June A.D. 1838. and recorded in Register of Deeds Con-
veyance Book T. page 410.

Together with all and singular the Rights,
Members, Cestudaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular
the Premises beforementioned, unto the said Charles B. Roberts his Heirs
and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors
and Administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the
said Premises, unto the said Charles B. Roberts his Heirs and Assigns,
against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever, lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
