down sd. Road S. 24° E. 9c 50l. to a stake thence N. 76° E. 16c.  
to a Spanish Q. same course to a stake w. L. H. Dicksys line  
thence running S. W. with Dicksys land to a Hickory Stump near  
the R. Q. thence running with Dicksys land to a P. Q. on Mostellers
