district aforesaid in consideration of Two Hundred Dollars to me paid by George Harrison of sd District I have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the sd George Harrison a plantation or tract of land lying & being in Greenville District on the waters of Wild Cat Creek of South Tiger river joining land surveyd for Sam Shall Beginning at a dead chestnut standing on the east side of what is called the dry branch and said to be Dennis Craigs south west & beginning corner of the tract of land on which he lives Thence running Northwardly up & with the meanders of sd branch to a stake In Mafouy Jacksons line thence westwardly with sd Jacksons line crossing the road leading from David Jacksons to the sd Mafouy Jacksons to a stake in sd Mafouys line thence South to the sd David Jacksons North East corner of the tract of land on which he lives & North with his line crossing Wild Cat Creek to a stake said Jacksons South East corner and in the North boundary of Savannah Loftis track of land Thence Eastwardly with Loftises line to a stake in a field in the line of a track of Land now owned by John H. Hampton thence westwardly with Hampton to his corner thence northwardly crossing sd Creek with sd line to said Hampton's north west corner to an Oak thence eastwardly with Hampton's line crossing sd dry branch to the beginning containing by estimation Ninety three Acres be the same more or less To have & to hold unto the sd George Harrison his heirs & assigns for ever the aforesd Land & Bargained premises with all and singular the woods water courses and Reridatayments and appurtainances there unto belonging or in any wise appertaining and I the sd William Harrison do bind myself my heirs & my Administrators to warrant and defend all the sd premises before mentioned, unto the sd George Harrison his heirs & assigns for ever
