J. Jones lately resided, beginning in a Red Oak corner, a dividing Corner made between William Butler and Pent. Wood and runs N. 23 E. 42 to a stake 3 x thence in Rims line thence in said line N E. to a Red Oak thence S 4 E 17.50 to a Red Oak 3 x thence S 30 W. 15 thence S. 31 W 21 thence S 30 W 19 to a Post Oak 3 x thence N 45 W 22 to the beginning Corner— together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to Have and to Hold all the aforesaid premises unto the said William Greer his Heirs Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} &c and I do hereby warrant and fower defend the same unto the said William Greer his Heirs Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} &c. against myself my Heirs Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} &c. and from every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
