J. Jones lately resided, beginning on a Red Oak corner, a dividing corner made between William Butler and Penl. Wood and runs N. 28 E. 42 to a stake 3x thence on Rims line thence on said line N. E. to a Red Oak thence S. 64 E. 17. 50 to a Red Oak 3x thence S. 30 W. 15 thence S. 31 W. 21 thence S. 30 W. 19 to a Post Oak 3x thence W. 45 W. 22 to the begining corner together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all the aforesaid premises unto the said William Greer his heirs Ex<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>. &c and I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same unto the said William Greer his heirs Ex<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>. &c against myself my heirs Ex<sup>r</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup>. &c and from every person or persons whosoever claiming the same or any part thereof.
