of said have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Alfred Cantrell a
tract a parcel of land, situated in the District of Greenville and State
of said lying on the North side of Bear dam creek it being a part of a sur-
vey originally granted to William Gough and bounded as follows viz lying
at a Stake at the mouth of a ditch on Bear dam creek running S 29. W.
of the 70 S. to a White, thence S 59. W. 5. 32. to a Chestnut tree a branch on
the same line, thence S. 44. E. 5. Ch. to a Stake on the same branch thence down
the Meanders of the branch to the beginning corner containing Five Acres
to the same now a leg together with the all and singular the rights men and
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way
wise incident or appurtenant, to have and to hold all and singular the prem-
ises before mentioned unto the said Alfred Cantrell his heirs and assigns forever and
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Alfred Cantrell his heirs
and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal the 20th
day of July 1848 in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred
and forty eight
